AMENDMENT

case where the member of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission who is the  
Chairman of the Departmental Promotion Committee requires that the  
Commission should be consulted, *such consultation shall be made. The decision  
of the Commission in such cases, Shall be communicated direct to the  
Government by the Secretary to the Commission.\*\**
