IX. NOTIFICATION :

The Commission advertised 37 notifications comprising 3,170 vacancies in 51 posts under different services of the State.

(For details see Annexure-IV.)

X. REFORMS AND RATIONALISATION :

The Commission is continuously engaged in reviewing its selection process taking into consideration the latest developments in organisations similar to Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission engaged in recruitment work.

SECTION II.

DIRECT RECRUITMENT :

During the period the Commission conducted preliminary examination for 4 recruitments for 50 vacancies. 37,933 were admitted to the Preliminary examination. The Commission conducted main written examination for 53 recruitments consisting of 2,446 vacancies. 34,638 candidates were admitted to main written examination. The Commission conducted oral examination for 35 recruitments containing 473 vacancies. 1,231 were admitted to oral examination. The Commission finally recommended 537 candidates for appointments through written-cum-oral tests and 1982 candidates for appointment through written examination alone. Thus 2,519 candidates were selected for appointment in 34 recruitments. The details of 34 recruitments statistics are given in the Annexure-II.

GROUP SERVICES.

GROUP I SERVICES.

The Commission issued notification on 15th June 1992 for Group-I Services examinations containing 30 vacancies. 32,879 applications were received. The preliminary examination was held on 3rd October 1992. On the basis of preliminary examination, 300 candidates have been admitted to main written examination. The main written examination was conducted from 26th March 1993 to 31st March 1993.

GROUP-IV SERVICES :

In Group IV Services (1991) 20,889 were admitted to main written examination. On the basis of main written examination 1971 candidates were selected and allotted to 120 various departmental units.

The Commission issued notification on 6th February 1993 for Group-IV Services consisting 2,700 vacancies. 3,63,382 applications were received from candidates. The preliminary examination is proposed to be held on 18th July 1993.

GROUP V SERVICES

The Commission issued notification on 22nd February 1993 for Group V Services containing 9 vacancies. 2,400 applications were received. The preliminary examination is proposed to be held in the month of October 1993.

GROUP VII SERVICES—

The Commission issued notification on 27th December 1992 for Group VII Services containing vacancies for the posts of Executive Officer Grade I and Grade III. 6,170 applications were admitted to the preliminary examination. The preliminary examination was held on 4th April 1993.

GROUP VIII SERVICES—

The Commission issued notification on 27th December 1992 for Group VIII Services consisting 24 vacancies for the post of Executive Officer Grade IV. 11,916 applications were received. The preliminary examination is proposed to be held on 27th June 1993.

Preliminary Examination—

During the period under report the Commission conducted 4 preliminary examinations, consisting of 60 vacancies. 37,933 were admitted to preliminary examinations,

Main written Examination—

During the period under report the Commission conducted 53 main written examination to fill up 2,446 vacancies. 34,638 candidates were admitted to those main written examination.

Oral Examination—

During the period under report the Commission conducted oral test for 35 recruitments to fill up 473 vacancies. The Commission sat for interview on 40 days. The oral tests were held in two sessions one in F.N. and the other in the A.N. Maximum of 4 Boards sat in both sessions on some days 1,231 candidates were admitted to oral test. 178 total sessions took place in the current year. The details of preliminary, main written and oral examination are given in Annexure-V.

SECTION- III

Paucity of qualified and suitable candidates for certain Categories of Post.

There were paucity of qualified and suitable candidates for certain categories of posts like Accounts Officer Class III-4, Assistant Training Officer (Steno-English) — 2 and Group-IV Services - 29.

Thus a total of 35 vacancies could not be filled up during this year.

3. STATUTORY RULES, REGULATIONS, ETC.

In 968 cases the Commission's concurrence was sought for and given under the later part of Regulation 16(b) of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulation 1954 for making appointment to the posts in the State, Subordinate and Ministerial Service. In 23 cases, the Commission refused to accord such concurrence.

4. TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS—

The Commission accorded its concurrence for the continuance of temporary appointments in different posts included in Tamil Nadu State/Subordinate/Ministerial Services within the period of 24 months in 452 cases and refused 107 cases and for more than 24 months, in 911 cases the concurrence was accorded and in 712 cases the concurrence was refused.

5. Concurrence under Rule 20 (a)(iii) of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service.

The Commission accorded its consent under the provision in Rule 20(c)(ii) of the special rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service for the permanent transfer of 276 personnel from one departmental unit to another departmental unit within the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service.

6. Promulgation and Amendments—

During the period under report, there were 145 cases of issue of statutory Rules or amendment to them by the Government. Of them, in respect of 128 cases, the Commission was consulted. before the rules were issued and in 17 cases. The Commission was not consulted. However, those cases relate either to posts excluded from the purview of the Commission or to matters in respect of which under Article 320(3) of the Constitution of India Consultation with the Commission was not necessary.

7. RELAXATION

During the period under report, there were 247 cases in which Statutory rules relating to age and educational qualifications as the case may be, were relaxed by the Government.

In one case, orders of relaxation were issued by the Government in respect of pension matters. in 9 Cases, orders of relaxation were issued in respect of certain provisions of the Fundamental Rules, Tamil Nadu Special Pay and Allowances Rules and the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowances Rules. In No case orders of relaxation was issued by the Government in respect of certain provisions of the General Provident Fund (MPFAS) Rules.

SECTION.—V

Other than Recruitment Examinations

I. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION.

The departmental tests were conducted in May and November 1992. The total number of tests conducted were 299 and the number of candidates applied to the tests were 1,06,113. the details are given below.

II. HALF-YEARLY EXAMINATIONS.

119 and 134 candidates respectively appeared in the September 1992 and March 1993, Half yearly examination including first class Language test in Tamil conducted for Assistant Collectors, Police Officers and Forest Officers.

III. PROFICIENCY TEST IN TAMIL.

The Commission issued notification in September 1992 inviting applications for proficiency test in Tamil for all Indian Officers whose Mother Tongue is not Tamil. None applied to this examination.

IV. RASHTRIYA INDIAN MILITARY COLLEGE SCHOOL, DEHRA DUN, EXAMINATION.

The Commission conducted an examination on behalf of the Government of India Ministry of Defence in August 1992 and in February 1993, for selection of candidates for admission to Rashtriya Indian Military College School in Dehra Dun. 68 and 142 candidates appeared for the examination. No one was selected in August 1992 examination and results are awaited for the examination held in February 1993.

SECTION VI.

REFORMS AND RATIONALISATION :

(i) The recruitment examinations (written) are planned and conducted on a quarterly basis. This procedure facilitates advance planning in seeking of accommodation and in appointing invigilators. It also yields economy in expenditure on rent, transportation and other examination works.

(ii) On the advice of the Commission the State Government have enhanced the rate of remuneration paid to invigilators who are conducting the Commission's examination on behalf of the Commission.

SECTION- VII

NON-ACCEPTANCE OF COMMISSION'S ADVICE.

During the year under report the Government have not deviated from the Commission's advice.

The Commission was not consulted in one case. Wherein it should have been consulted before the issue of executive orders. Thus the Government have violated their own instructions and the Commission trust that this will not recur in future.

The details of the number of cases in which the Government have not accepted the Commission's advice the Government have not consulted the Commission are given for the latest five years in Annexure-XI.

B. NON-CONSULTATION WITH COMMISSION IN CERTAIN CASES.

1. G.O. Ms. No. 1077, Transport department, dated 4th October 1985.

In May 1989, the Government in the Labour and Employment Department while seeking the commission's views on their proposal to dispense with the direct recruitment method for appointment to the post of Inspector of Factories had cited the orders issued in Government letter (No. 1077, Transport, dated 4th October 1985) dispensing with direct recruitment method of appointment to the post of Assistant Divisional Engineer in the Highways and Rural Works Department. While examining the above proposal it was seen that the Commission was not consulted before the said orders were issued. According to the instructions issued in U.O. No. 4020/54-2, Public (s) dated 11th September 1954, the Commission should be consulted before any decision, affecting.

the method of recruitment or the principle followed in making appointment to the posts within its purview, is taken and not merely at the time of framing of rules or issuing the amendments thereto. Hence, the Government were requested to state the circumstances under which the Commission was not consulted before the above orders were issued. In reply, the Government have stated that the decision to dispense with the direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Divisional Engineer was taken based on the similar decision in respect of Assistant Executive Engineer in the Tamil Nadu Engineering Service. The Government also stated that orders were issued in G.O. Ms. No. 1884, Public Works Department dated 12-9-84 cancelling the orders issued in G.O. Ms. No. 1267, Public Works Department dated 23-6-82 for revival of old practice of direct recruitment to the category of Assistant Executive Engineer in the Tamil Nadu Engineering Service. Incidentally the Commission was not consulted before orders were issued in respect of the Tamil Nadu Engineering Service also. This is a case of violation of the Government's own instructions issued in this regard.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT.

The Commission records its appreciation of the willing co-operation extended by various trusts, Educational institutions and their officers in the matter of providing suitable accommodation for the various examinations held by the Commission.

The Commission is also grateful to the examiners and expert advisers who inspite of their personal inconvenience readily accepted the Commission's invitations and assisted it in the conduct of different examinations and selections of officers to various posts under the State Government.

Finally the Commission places on record its appreciation of the loyal and efficient service rendered by its staff throughout the year.
