SECTION - I

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has to discharge the duties and functions specified in Article 320 of the Constitution of India. The Commission is required to advise the Government on all matters relating to framing of recruitment rules, principles to be followed in making appointments and promotions and transfers from one service to another service, in respect of disciplinary matters affecting Government Servants and to conduct examinations for selection of candidates under direct recruitment to the State, Subordinate and Ministerial Services. The Commission conducts Departmental Examinations for Government Servants and also conducts the examination on behalf of the Government of India, Ministry of Defence for admission to the school run by the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehra Dun.

10. REFORMS AND RATIONALIZATION

The Commission is continuously engaged in reviewing its selection process taking into consideration the latest developments in organizations similar to Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission engaged in recruitment work.

SECTION - II

DIRECT RECRUITMENT:

During the period under report, the Commission finalised 11 recruitments containing 3,466 vacancies and recommended 3,226 candidates for appointments. The recruitment statistics in respect of 11 recruitments are given in Annexure - II.

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATIONS:

During the period under report, the Commission conducted one Preliminary examination for Group-I Services to fill up 61 Vacancies. 98,682 Candidates were admitted to this Preliminary Examination.

MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

During the period under report, the Commission conducted 19 Main Written Examinations to fill up 5,789 vacancies. 15,55,676 candidates were admitted to these Main Written Examinations.

ORAL EXAMINATION:

During the period under report, the Commission conducted Oral Test for 17 Recruitments to fill up 4775 vacancies. The Commission conducted interviews on 77 days. The Oral Tests were held in two sessions, one in the F.N. and the other in the A.N., a maximum of 7 Boards were constituted in both the sessions on some days, 7,419 candidates were admitted to Oral Test. Totally 461 Boards took place in 77 days for the current year.

SECTION - III

<u>Paucity of Qualified and Suitable candidates:</u> There were paucity of qualified and suitable candidates for the post of Assistant Medical Officer Unani-22, Assistant Surgeon(General and Specialty-)-217, Motor Vehicle Inspector Grade-II-1 As a result 240 vacancies could not be filled up during this year. The community wise details are given in Annexure –VI.

5. CONCURRENCE UNDER RULE 20(a) (iii) OF THE SPECIAL RULES FOR THE TAMIL NADU MINISTERIAL SERVICE.

The Commission accorded its consent under the provision in Rule 20(a)(iii) of the Special Rules of Tamil Nadu Ministerial Services for the permanent transfer of 42 personnel from one departmental unit to another departmental unit within the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service and in no case, consent was refused.

6. PROMULGATION AND AMENDMENTS:

During the period under report, there were 86 cases of issue of statutory rules or amendments to them by the Government. Of them, in respect of 74 cases, the Commission was consulted before the rules were issued and in 12 cases the Commission was not consulted. However, these cases relate either to posts excluded from the purview of the Commission or to matters in respect of which under Article 320(3) of the Constitution of India, consultation with Commission is not necessary.

7. RELAXATION:

During the period under report, there were 9 cases in which statutory rules relating to age and educational qualifications as the case may be, were relaxed by the Government.

SECTION - V

OTHER THAN RECRUITMENT EXAMINATIONS

I. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION:

Departmental Tests were conducted in May and December 2010. The total number of tests conducted were 331 and the number of candidates applied to the tests were 1,87,573.

II. HALF YEARLY EXAMINATION:

145 and 126 candidates appeared in September 2010 and March 2011 respectively. Half Yearly Examination including First Class Language Test in Tamil was conducted for Officers of Indian Administrative Service, Indian Police Service, Indian Forest Service and State services.

III. RASHTRIYA INDIAN MILITARY COLLEGE SCHOOL, DEHRA DUN EXAMINATION:

The Commission conducted the Examination on behalf of the Government of India, Ministry of Defence in August 2010 and in February 2011 for selection of candidates for admission to the Rashtriya Indian Military College School in Dehra Dun. 49 and 37 candidates respectively appeared for the examination.

SECTION - VI

GOVERNMENT AND THE COMMISSION

A. NON ACCEPTANCE OF COMMISSION'S ADVICE:

During the year under report, the Government have deviated from the Commission's advice in Three cases. The details are as follows:-

Case-1

(G.O.(D) No.1188, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 06.11.2009)

Disciplinary action was initiated against Dr.E.Geetha, (Petitioner), Senior Civil Assistant Surgeon, Secretariat Dispensary, Chennai, by issuing show cause notice under rule 17(a) of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules for having issued Medical Certificate to two Secretariat employees in a casual manner. After following the prescribed formalities, the Director of Medical Education held substantiated all the lapses on the part of the Petitioner and imposed the punishment of stoppage of increment for one year without cumulative effect on the Petitioner for the proved lapses. The Petitioner thereafter, filed appeal to the Government and the Government rejected the appeal on the advice of the Commission. The Petitioner, thereafter filed a Petition to the Government. The Government, as required under Regulation 19 of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulation 1954, sought the views of the Commission. The Commission once again examined the case with the relevant records and found that the Petitioner has issued Medical Certificate mechanically and in a casual manner without proper investigation and careful examination. However, considering the 18 years of service put in by the Petitioner and mental agony suffered by her because of this disciplinary Proceedings, the Commission advised the Government to modify the punishment of stoppage of increment for one year without cumulative effect into stoppage of increment for 6 months without cumulative affect. But the Government did not accept the above views of the Commission and in G.O.(D) No.1188, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 06.11.2009 issued orders setting aside the punishment of stoppage of increment for one year without cumulative effect imposed on the Petitioner. Thus, the Government issued orders in deviation from the commission's views.

Case-II

(G.O.Ms.No.344, Home (SC) Department, Dated 01.04.2010)

Disciplinary action was initiated under rule 17(a) of Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules against Thiru. S.Kannan, (Revision Petitioner) Section Officer formerly Home (SC) Department, for the gross negligence of duty in replying a query raised by the under Secretary to Government, Home Department and for having removed the portion of the Note file wherein the Under Secretary to Government, had raised the query and for having sent a reminder to the Director General of Police at the section level without answering the query. After examining the explanation submitted by him, the revision petitioner was imposed with the punishment of 'Censure' by the Principal Secretary to Government in G.O.Ms.No.824, dated 21.7.2008.

Aggrieved by this, Thiru.S.Kannan, Section Officer has submitted his 'Appeal' to the Chief Secretary, which was rejected by him for the reason that there are no merits in the appeal and a 'Mercy Petition' to the Principal Secretary was not entertained by the Principal Secretary, Home Department, as there is no provision in the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and appeal) Rules.

Again Thiru. S.Kannan, Section Officer has preferred a Revision petition requesting the Government to review his petition and to cancel the punishment imposed on him. The Government have sought the view of the Commission uder Regulation 18(1)(a) of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations, 1954 on the revision petition.

The Commission after examining the case carefully has advised the Government to reject the revision petition as devoid of merits in view of the fact that the query raised by a superior officer was unanswered, which is an unbecoming conduct on the part of revision petitioner and this shows that there was an Intentional insubordination.

But the Government have decided to deviate from the views of the Commission and to cancel the punishment of 'Censure' imposed on him and issued orders accordingly in G.O.Ms.No.344, Home(SC) Department, dated 1.4.2010.

Thus, the Government have issued orders in deviation from the Commission's views.

Case-III

(G.O.(D) No.425, Co-operation, Food and Consumer Protection (CL1)

Department, dated 20.09.2010)

Thiru.G.Harikrishnan (Delinquent Officer) (now retd.), while working as Co-operative Sub-Registrar (Criminal) in the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Loan) of Co-operative Societies, had committed certain irregularities in his office work. Hence, a charge was framed against him under Rule 17 (b) of Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules. After following the prescribed formalities, the Government agreed with the finding of the Inquiry Officer. For the proven charges, the Government arrived at a provisional decision to impose the punishment of cut in pension at the rate of Rs.500/- per month for one year. The delinquent officer was directed to state specifically whether he accepted the said provisional decision of the Government or not. The delinquent officer accepted the provisional decision of the Government with high objection and protest. Hence, the Government sought the views of the Commission under regulation 18(1) (c) of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations 1954.

However, Considering the nature of delinquency and the fact that the delinquent officer stood retired, the Commission advised the Government to impose the punishment of a cut in pension at the rate of Rs.200/- per month for one year, instead of a cut in pension at the rate of Rs.500/- per month for a year. But, the Government deviated from the above views of the Commission and decided to issue orders to confirm the provisional decision already arrived at in regard to the punishment of a cut in pension at the rate of Rs.500/- per month for one year. Accordingly, the

Government issued orders in G.O.(D) No.425, Co-operation, Food and Consumer Protection (CL1) Department, dated 20.09.2010. Thus, the Government issued orders in deviation from the Commission's views.

- C. The Government have deviated their own instructions and the Commission trust that this will not recur in future. Details of the number of cases in which Government have not accepted the Commission's advice and the number of cases in which Government have not consulted the Commission are given for the last five years in Annexure XII.




