SECTION - I

FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

The Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has to discharge the duties and functions specified in Article 320 of the Constitution of India. The Commission is required to advise the Government on all matters relating to framing of recruitment rules, principles to be followed in making appointments and promotions and transfers from one service to another service, in respect of disciplinary matters affecting Government Servants and to conduct examinations for selection of candidates under direct recruitment to the State, Subordinate and Ministerial Services. The Commission conducts Departmental Examinations for Government Servants and also conducts the examination on behalf of the Government of India, Ministry of Defence for admission to the school run by the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehra Dun.

10. **REFORMS AND RATIONALIZATIONS**

- 1) **Answer Keys published in the website.** The Answer keys for the objective type Examination is hosted in the Commission's Website immediately after the examination is over and the candidate will be given seven days time to file claims and objections, if any, to the Commission. The corrected answer keys will be published in the website again. Candidates can self evaluate their answers with the answer keys. The scanned copy of the answer sheets of all candidates will be uploaded in the website after the publication of results enabling the candidates to download the same. The candidates will be permitted to peruse their descriptive type Answer Scripts in the Commission's office, which will ensure more transparency in the activities of the Commission.
- 2) **Video graph/Web Camera for the Examination process:-** To prevent any malpractice in the Examination halls, all the Examination centers will be monitored through web camera/Video graph. All the proceedings of the oral test are being video graphed to ensure transparency.
- 3) **Annual Planner:-** This Annual planner will be of great help to the candidates to plan their choice of posts and prepare well in advance. The concerned Department can also plan their Human Resources Management including Training Programme for new recruits.
- 4) **Online Application:-** The Commission has decided to introduce online application system for all Recruitment Examinations conducted by the Commission. The online applications will be Bilingual (Tamil and English) in format and most user friendly. The payment of fees can be made in Post Office or Indian Bank Branches in the State and through Payment by Net Banking and also by using credit cards and Debit cards. For the Convenience of Rural candidates to setup Facilitation counters in 500 place across the State.

- 5) **One Time Registration:** Candidates can fill their Bio-data particulars and also upload signature and photo by paying Rs.50/-. This Registration will be valid for five years period, which can be renewed. Candidates can apply for any post by mentioning their Register numbers and they need not pay applications fees. A permanent Data base of the candidates will be created.
- 6) **Counseling for allocation of Units/Departments:-** The Commission has introduced the allocation of post/Unit/Services by counseling method. This will ensure transparency in allocation. In this method, all the selected candidates would be called to appear at Chennai and the vacancy particulars will be published in the website, the Service/Unit/Post will be allocated to the candidates based on their merit and choice, subject to availability of vacancy in their respective category during their turn in counseling.
- 7) **Single Window System in D.P.C:-** The Concerned Secretariat Department through their designated senior officials in the rank of Joint Secretary, in respect of posts for which the Government are the appointing authority/Joint Director in respect of post for which Head of the Department is the appointing authority, shall bring the proposals in person to hand over the same in the Commission's office and the proposals will be scrutinized by the officials of the Commission on the same day. The proposals in complete shape will be subjected to further scrutiny and placed in Department Promotion Committee meeting in a week time. The incomplete proposals will be returned on the same day with a note on rectification to be carried out.

SECTION – II

DIRECT RECRUITMENTS:

During the period under report, the Commission finalized 26 recruitments containing 8972 vacancies and recommended 8958 candidates for appointments. The recruitment statistics in respect of 26 recruitments are given in Annexure - II.

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATIONS :

During the period under report, the Commission conducted one Preliminary examination for Group-I Services to fill up 131 Vacancies. 1,49,687 Candidates were applied for this Preliminary Examination.

MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

During the period under report, the Commission conducted 11 Main Written Examinations to fill up 7,104 vacancies. 4,46,392 candidates applied for these Main Written Examinations.

ORAL EXAMINATION:

During the period under report, the Commission conducted Oral Test for 35 Posts to fill up 921 vacancies. The Commission conducted interviews on 23 days. The Oral Tests were held in two sessions (in the F.N. and in the A.N), a maximum of 7 Boards were constituted in both the sessions on some days, 1,892 candidates were admitted to Oral Test. Totally 263 Oral Test Boards took place in 23 days for the current year.

The details of Preliminary, Main Written and Oral Examinations conducted are given in Annexure-V.

SECTION – III

Paucity of Qualified and Suitable candidates:- There were paucity of qualified and suitable candidates for the post of Health Officer-I, Scientific Assistant Grade-II-2, Child Development Project Officer-I, Combined Subordinate Services Examination-I-4, Combined Engineering Services Examination-5, As a result 13 vacancies could not be filled up during this year. The community wise details are given in Annexure –VI.

During the period, the Commission dealt with references relating to recruitment by transfer to State Services from the corresponding Subordinate Services and by promotions within the State Services and drew up lists of 753 qualified and suitable candidates for appointment to the posts under 18 Services. 3. STATUTORY RULES, REGULATION, ETC.:

In 632 cases, the Commission's concurrence was sought for and given under the latter part of Regulation 16(b) of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations 1954 for making appointment to the posts in the State, Subordinate and Ministerial Services.

5. CONCURRENCE UNDER RULE 20(a) (iii) OF THE SPECIAL RULES FOR THE TAMIL NADU MINISTERIAL SERVICE.

The Commission accorded its consent under the provision in Rule 20(a)(iii) of the Special Rules of Tamil Nadu Ministerial Services for the permanent transfer of 75 personnel from one departmental unit to another departmental unit within the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service and in no case, consent was refused.

6. PROMULGATION AND AMENDMENTS:

During the period under report, there were 18 cases of issue of statutory rules or amendments to them by the Government. Of them, in respect of 17 cases, the Commission was consulted before the rules were issued and in 1 case the Commission was not consulted. However, this case relates to the post excluded from the purview of the Commission and to the matter, in respect of which under Article 320(3) of the Constitution of India, consultation with Commission is not necessary.

7. RELAXATION:

During the period under report, there were 39 cases in which statutory rules relating to age and educational qualifications as the case may be, were relaxed by the Government.

SECTION – V

OTHER THAN RECRUITMENT EXAMINATIONS

I. DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION:

Departmental Tests were conducted in May and December 2011. The total number of tests conducted were 331 and the number of candidates applied for the tests were 1,86,557.

II. HALF YEARLY EXAMINATION:

101 and 42 candidates appeared in September 2011 and March 2012 respectively. Half Yearly Examination including First Class Language Test in Tamil was conducted for Officers of Indian Administrative Service, Indian Police Service, Indian Forest Service and State services.

III. RASHTRIYA INDIAN MILITARY COLLEGE SCHOOL, DEHRA DUN EXAMINATION:

The Commission conducted the Examination on behalf of the Government of India, Ministry of Defence in June 2011 and in December 2011 for selection of candidates for admission to the Rashtriya Indian Military College School in Dehra Dun. 63 and 60 candidates respectively appeared for the examination.

SECTION – VI

GOVERNMENT AND THE COMMISSION

A. NON ACCEPTANCE OF COMMISSION'S ADVICE:

During the year under report, the Government have deviated from the Commission's advice in one case. The details are as follows:-

Case-1

(G.O.(D) No.124, School Education (M2) Department, dated: 30.04.2010).

While Thiru.N.Venugopal was working as school Assistant Teacher (Tamil) at Government Higher Secondary School, Sholavaram, Tiruvallore District, disciplinary action was initiated against him under Rule 17(b) of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules for his involvement in the leakage of Government Examination question paper, prior to the conduct of the examination. Based on the investigation done by the CB-CID Police and after conducting departmental inquiry, the Government held the charge as proved and for the proven charge they have arrived at a provisional conclusion to impose the punishment of cut in pension of Rs.500/- per month for a period of three years and have sought the views of the Commission as the delinquent officer had not accepted the proposed penalty.

The Commission while offering its views have stated that the inquiry officer in his findings has held the charge as proved based on the statement of the witness deposed by Thiru.Raja given before the Police who has later turned as hostile in the departmental inquiry.

The findings of the inquiry officer are not correct as it is against the rules relating to disciplinary procedures and also against natural justice. As per the rules of disciplinary procedures, report of the inquiry officer should be based only on the evidences adduced during the inquiry and not on the deposition given prior to the conduct of departmental inquiry. Therefore, the conclusion of the inquiry officer is fundamentally incorrect and not valid and that relying upon the statement made to the police prior to the departmental inquiry as evidence will not qualify even for the standard of "preponderance of probability". Therefore, the Commission advised the Government to relieve the delinquent officer from the charges and to drop further action.

But, the Government in deviation to the views of the Commission have issued orders in G.O.(D) No.124, School Education(M2) Department dated 30.04.2010, imposing the punishment of cut in pension of Rs.500/- per month for a period of 3 years on the delinquent Officer. Thus, the Government have issued orders in deviation from the Commission's views.

B. Non-consultation with the Commission : NIL

C. The Government have deviated their own instructions and the Commission trust that this will not recur in future. Details of the number of cases in which Government have not accepted the Commission's advice and the number of cases in which Government have not consulted the Commission are given for the last five years in Annexure – XII.

The Commission records its appreciation for the co-operation extended by educational Institutions and their officers in the matter of providing suitable accommodation for conduct of examinations by the Commission.

The Commission is also grateful to the examiners and experts who, in spite of their personal inconvenience, readily accepted the Commission's invitation and assisted them in the conduct of different examinations and selection of officers to various posts under the State Government.

The Commission expresses its sincere thanks to all the Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments for their kind co-operation in finalizing the selection of candidates for appointment by recruitment by transfer/promotion through the Departmental Promotion Committees.

In conclusion, the Commission also places on record its appreciation for the Co-operation and efforts of all the staff Members in the smooth functioning of the Commission.

MEMORANDUM EXPLAINING THE REASONS FOR DEVIATION FROM THE ADVICE OF TAMIL NADU PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN THE CASE REFERRED TO IN SECTION VIth OF THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE TAMIL NADU PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR THE YEAR 2011-2012.

Case-1

While Thiru. N. Venugopal was working as school Assistant Teacher (Tamil) at Government Higher Secondary School, Sholavaram, Tiruvallore District, disciplinary action was initiated against him under Rule 17(b) of the Tamil Nadu Civil Service (Discipline and Appeal) Rules for his involvement in the leakage of Government Examination question paper, prior to the conduct of the examination. Based on the investigation done by the CB-CID Police and after conducting departmental inquiry, the Government held the charge as proved and for the proven charge they have arrived at a provisional conclusion to impose the punishment of cut in pension of Rs.500/- per month for a period of three years and have sought the views of the Commission as the delinquent officer had not accepted the proposed penalty.

2. The Commission while offering its views have stated that the inquiry officer in his findings has held the charge as proved based on the statement of the witness disposed by Thiru. Raja given before the Police who has later turned as hostile in the department inquiry. The findings of the inquiry officer are not correct as it is against the rules relating to disciplinary procedures and also against natural justice. As per the rules of disciplinary procedures, report of the inquiry officer should be based only on the evidences adduced during the inquiry and not on the deposition given prior to the conduct of departmental inquiry. Therefore, the conclusion of the inquiry officer is

fundamentally incorrect and not valid and that relying upon the statement made to the police prior to the departmental inquiry as evidence will not qualify even for the standard of "preponderance of probability". Therefore, the commission advised the Government to relieve the delinquent officer from the charges and to drop further action.

3. But the Government in deviation to the views of the Commission have issued orders in G.O.(D) No.124, School Education (M2) Department, dated 30.04.2010, imposing the punishment of cut in pension of Rs.500/- per month for a period of 3 years on the delinquent Officer. Thus, the Government have issued orders in deviation from the Commission's views.

THE FACTORS THAT PROMPTED THE GOVERNMENT TO ISSUE AN ORDER AGAINST THE ADVICE OF THE COMMISSION ARE DETAILED BELOW:-

The complaint in this regard is that one Thiru Raja (witness) bought the Government exam question paper from Thiru N.Venugopal (delinquent officer) by giving money and leaked out the same, prior to the conduct of the examination. Thiru Raja had accepted the above complaint during the police inquiry but subsequently during the judicial inquiry, refused the same and hence turned hostile in the department inquiry. Therefore, the case was dismissed by the Hon'ble court as there is no proof to conclude the complaint against Thiru N.Venugopal. Though the court has dismissed the case, the department has decided to give the penalty to the delinquent officer, based on the report of the inquiry officer stating the charge as proved based on the deposition given by the witness Thiru Raja during the police inquiry. Accordingly, the Government in deviation to the views of the commission have

issued orders in G.O.(Ms) No 124 School Education (M2) Department, dated 30.04.2010, imposing the punishment of cut in pension of Rs.500/- per month for a period of 3 years to the delinquent officer. The same has been intimated to the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission vide the Government letter No.11535/M2/06, dated 30.04.2010.
