ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has stated that certain candidates who have applied to the Commission for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) in the Combined Engineering Service possessed the qualification of a pass in Direct Final Examination in Building and Quantity Surveying conducted by the Institution of Surveyors (India) for considering the above said qualification as equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) in the Combined Engineering Service, the subject was placed before the Equivalence Committee meeting held on 17.11.2008. The Committee has resolved not to recommend to consider the qualification of a pass in Direct Final Examination in Building and Quantity Surveying conducted by the Institution of Surveyors (India) as equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) in the Combined Engineering Services (Resolution No.5). He has therefore requested to issue orders of Government in the matter.

The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission and direct that a pass in the Direct final examination in Building and Quantity Surveying conducted by the Institution of Surveyors (India) be not equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) included in Combined Engineering Service.
